The training will be presented by the Springfield Police Department, and last approximately two hours. Ample time will be made available for questions.

The skills and information shared during the training will be applicable to venues of all sizes and in all locations. This invitation is open to all Mass Cultural Council grantees and to all members of your staff. Those who frequently work with members of the public are especially encouraged to attend. Please note that this training is limited to 120 participants, and that you must register in advance to participate.
