Agawam Cultural Council Sponsoring a spring “Plan Your Own Day” Bus Trip to New York City

The Agawam Cultural Council is sponsoring a “Plan Your Own Day” Bus Trip to New York City on Saturday, May 6, 2017. Activities such as museum and gallery exhibits, theatre and music performances, street festivals and shopping are available to those going on the trip. Running two buses in tandem, a member of the council, acting as “leader” on each bus will be available to help with information and suggestions along the way. The buses are scheduled to make five stops in Manhattan: The Metropolitan Museum of Art, Rockefeller Center/Radio City, Times Square/TKTS, 34th Street (Macy’s), and finally, the South Street Seaport. Riders may elect to get off at any of these scheduled stops. Further details, a map to the departure point, plus handy NYC links, can be found at www.agawamcc.org (click on “*Bus Trips*”).

Buses depart the Roberta G. Doering School (formerly known as the Agawam Middle School), 68 Main Street, Agawam, Mass., from the parking lot in the rear of the building at 7:00 AM *sharp*. Please arrive NO LATER than 6:45 A.M.

Tickets are available now. The price is \$45 per person for both residents and non-residents alike. This is a very popular trip and seating is limited to 108, on a first come / first served basis. Tickets are assigned only as payments arrive, and **cannot be reserved by phone.**
