Sean Gaskell will give a performance and educational demonstration on the Kora, an ancient and melodic 21-stringed harp from West Africa native to the Mande peoples who live within Gambia, Senegal, Mali, Guinea, and Guinea Bissau. Gaskell will feature traditional songs that make up the heart and soul of the Kora's musical repertoire in addition to his own personal compositions. Gaskell has been featured at numerous festivals in the US, Gambia, and Senegal.
